Mental health to context

in 5 AUSTRALIAN WORKERS SUFFER FROM A MENTAL HEALTH ISSUE

- 90% of employees think mental health is an important issue for their company, but only 50% think their workplace is mentally healthy.
- **75%** of people say a mentally healthy workplace is important when looking for a job.
- It is estimated that 45% of Australians will experience a mental health condition in their life, likely between the ages of 16-45.
- Suicide is the leading cause of death for Australians aged
 15-44.
- Workplace bullying is estimated to cost Australian organisations \$6-\$36 billion a year.
